Game on for ebalta UK

Tooling materials manufacturer ebalta Kunststoff and the UK distributor that it bought last year are to trade under a new name. Ebalta Kunststoff acquired its long-standing UK distributor Derby-based Denaco (UK) for an undisclosed sum at the end of last year.

From 1 November 2008, the business is to trade as ebalta UK and the firm will relocate to new premises in Castle Donington. From here it will supply PU and epoxy resin systems and boards. In addition to offices and a large warehouse, the building will incorporate a demonstration area and customer service facility.

"This is a very exciting time for us," explained ebalta UK md Darrell Cross, "and gives us a great opportunity to support our customers directly, with the backing and support of the ebalta group." Cross said the UK business, which currently has eight employees, will be introducing a range of innovative materials that have already been proven in mainland Europe.

The parent company, which is based in Rothenburg ob der Tauber, has a portfolio of over 3,000 products ebalta provides customers with products for foundry, design, rapid prototyping, composite components and more.

Ebalta has supplied RIM and vacuum casting materials to a design house that produced prototype parts of the iPod docking station and the speakers shown above.
